English

This half term we will be exploring persuasive writing linked to our Amazing Americas. The children will be reading lots of different types of persuasive texts including adverts and letters. They will create a holiday brochure for a destination in North or South America using the information learnt in our Topic lessons. We will be working hard to apply the new grammar and punctuation skills we have learnt this year.

Christian Values.

This term, we will be thinking about the value of service. In school, we will be exploring how we can serve others including people within our community.

Geography

The children will first find out about the continents of North and South America, and the countries that form them. They will also look in more detail at some of the contrasting regions of the Americas, finding out about the landscape, climate and locations of each area.



Science

We will be continuing to look at forces. Children will be able to explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity. We will also explore different resistances.

P.E

Our PE focus this half term will be fielding games including rounders and tennis. The children will be learning how to effectively strike and field when playing these sports.

Maths

In maths, Year 4-6 will be exploring decimals and percentages. The children will be learning about the relationship between decimals, percentages and fractions. Year 3 will be exploring in more detail and looking at tenths in relation to place value. Following on from this we will be exploring shape. As a class, we will be exploring the properties of different shapes by looking at a range of 2D and 3D shapes.

Religious Education

This term we will consider the theme of inspirational people. Thinking about the people who inspire us and those that inspire people of faith.
