The children have been exploring how different numbers can be represented using concrete materials. We also explored the importance of how different numbers can be written for example if I have 3 hundreds, 4 ten's and 3 ones and Mrs Andrews has 34 ten's and 3 ones, who has the biggest number?

In English, we have continued our reading of Coming to England by Floella Benjamin which tells the story of Floella coming to England from Trinidad and the journey she undertook. In class, we have been using our DERIC skills to unpick the text and find answers to our questions.
