Reception Induction Information for September 2021

This will help the children to get to know Miss Holloway and our wonderful Reception class and explore our wonderful EYFS setting with their soon-to-be Year 1 and 2 friends!

Getting to know our Reception pupils, so we can provide them with the very best support and settling into our setting is something we pride ourselves on.
